

Cycling to South

As experience and confidence can vary a lot, we recommend spending some time going through this information with your child and planning a safe route to school prior to them beginning to cycle to school.

Right hand turns at busy intersections are not recommended. **A right turn out of Dominion Avenue into Milton Street is not permitted.**

Students needing to cross Selwyn Street must walk their bikes across at the school crossing. Cycles are to be walked in the school grounds. Students should lock their bikes in the bike stands.
