

Important Information for 2026

Admission Day: Monday, 2 February 2026

You are asked to accompany your child to Admission Day for approximately 45 minutes. You will meet their teacher, who will answer any questions and outline aspects of class procedures, timetable, programmes and stationery requirements (school uniform is not required to be worn).

Please note: All students will find out their class/teacher for the year on Admission Day. It is important that Year 7 and Year 8 students attend Admission Day.

Please book a start time for Admission Day using the link or QR code below. Start time bookings are staggered at 10 minute intervals within the timeframes below:

- Morning Session - 9:30am -11.00am Year 7
- Afternoon Session - 12:00pm - 1:30pm Year 8

The sessions will be set up for Year 7 in the morning and Year 8 in the afternoon. However, if for some reason you are not able to make the relevant session, you can book into the other. If you have children in both years, you only need to book one start time in either session and both children can attend the same session.

Information regarding music and other activities will be available on Admission Day.

Costs for School Activities:

We encourage full payment of contributions to cover costs associated with school activities on Admission Day where possible, by Eftpos or credit card. Alternative methods of payment, such as regular automatic payments, can be arranged by ringing the school on 332 2408, or on Admission Day. For your guidance, an approximate figure to cover all major activities (including Year 7 day trips and Year 8 camps) is \$300-\$435. A more exact figure will be on your invoice on the Admission Day. Receipts for tax purposes will be issued for all payments.

Regular School Days:

The Christchurch South Karamata Intermediate regular school day is 8.40am to 2.45pm.
